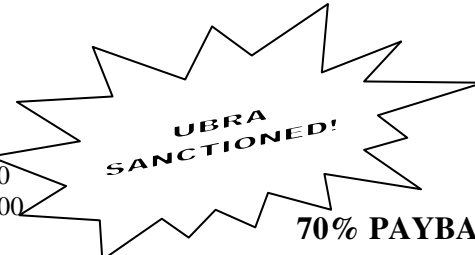
Boots and long pants are required to ride.
