General Information
Exhibition of Livestock in Minnesota
2010 Requirements

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

Livestock and poultry that exhibit symptoms of any infectious or communicable disease, including ringworm and warts, may not be exhibited. All animals must be examined by the official veterinarian on the day they are admitted to the exhibition and at least once daily during the exhibitions. All imported animals must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection and meet the Board's importation requirements.

CATTLE

No specific test or identification is required for cattle from Minnesota. TB testing has not been determined as of this date, check with Barn Superintendent or Web page closer to fair dates.

SHEEP and GOATS

All sheep and goats, including wethers, must be identified with official identification approved for use in the scrapie eradication program.

SWINE

Swine must be individually identified and must: (1) have had a negative official pseudorabies test conducted within 30 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition or (2) originate directly from a qualified pseudorabies-negative herd; or (3) originate directly from a Stage IV or V county or area. All 50 states are currently pseudorabies Stage V (Pseudorabies Free Status)

HORSES

All horses must be negative to an official test for Equine Infectious anemia (EIA) within 12 months prior to the opening date of the exhibition. A test is not required for suckling foals accompanying a negative dam.

POULTRY

Poultry, except waterfowl and pigeons, must be individually identified with a leg or wing band and accompanied by a form approved by the board to show compliance with one of the following: negative test for pullorum-typhoid disease conducted within 90 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition; originate directly from parent stock tested and found negative for pullorum-typhoid disease within the last 12 months. In addition, turkeys must be tested negative or originate directly from parent stock that is tested negative for *Salmonella typhimurium*, *Mycoplasma gallesepiticum*, and *Mycoplasma synoviae*.

DOGS

Dogs over six months of age must be accompanied by a certificate of rabies vaccination issued by a licensed veterinarian.

NOTE: SLAUGHTER CLASSES

All cattle, swine and poultry entered in the class which are kept isolated in a separate building from all other livestock and poultry at the exhibition and which are slaughtered during or immediately following the exhibition do not need tests or individual identification.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED**
- Entries must be PRE-REGISTERED with the superintendent no later than one week prior to entry day.
- Pens and stalls will be assigned by the superintendent on a first-come, first serve basis according to pre-registration date.
- Cattle do not have to be Bangs tested.
- It is understood that all exhibitors will be responsible for all care, feeding, watering, and cleaning of stalls and exhibit while animals remain at the Fair.
- Specific barn rules will be posted in the barn.
- Barns will be locked at 10:00PM , open at 5:AM., for show preparations.
- Release time is 5:00PM Sunday
- The number of entries per exhibitor will not be restricted in any lot; however, the premiums paid to any exhibitor will be limited to two placings in a lot.
