GENERAL REQUIREMENTS/NOTES:

- Participating horses must be housed in the barns from Thursday evening through barn clean-up Sunday evening of fair week.
- Participants must show proof of negative Coggins Test done within prior 6 months of fair dates.
- All participating horses must be in good health. Sick or unruly horses will be removed from the barn upon request of the superintendent.
- All exhibitors are expected to assist with barn clean-up starting at 3:00 p.m. Sunday.
- Sign-up for show events must be completed by Friday at noon.
- Draft Horse Show is intended for Driving Horses
- All breeds of horses will be shown together in their respective halter classes. Choose only one halter class per horse.
- Premiums will be paid for first five placing in each event unless otherwise noted.

Large barns were the center of daily activity and most of it involved horses. They were also used for pulling buggys, or drays, as well as pulling road graders. Some of the equipment will be on display during the fair depending on space limitations.
