Unless indicated, this department is limited to amateurs. All cut flowers must be grown by the exhibitor and should be in clear glass containers appropriate in size to that of specimen. Entries in the “other” categories must not include noxious weeds. Prop specimen in container; narrow necked containers are best for most flowers. Foliage should be removed under the water line and no extra green material is allowed, unless specified. Responsibility for entering only the specified number of blooms or stems for each lot is that of the exhibitor. Pot size will be enforced. Listing variety name on entry is desired in all classes. Any insect infested plants will be rejected.

Entries must be submitted between the hours of 12 noon to 7 p.m. on entry day, Wednesday, July 28, 2010, and must be picked up at 5 p.m. on the final day of the fair. Pre-registration greatly speeds up the entry process. Exhibitors with a large number of exhibits are encouraged to arrive early to avoid congestion. Late entries will not be accepted. All exhibitors are asked to come prepared with written entry information appropriate to category.

Planting medium should be a mix designated for container plants – NO GARDEN SOIL. Planters will be judged on quality of plants - vigor, free of disease and insects, cleanliness, number and size of plants proportionate to planter size. Name must be on bottom or back of container.
