CLASS 1 –FORESTRY KNOWLEDGE

Premiums: 1st-\$6.00 2nd - \$5.00 3rd - \$4.00

Lot 1 Tree Identification:
Enter a display of at least five trees that are common to Beltrami County with samples of the following; leaves or needles, bark, seeds or cones and finished wood samples.

Lot 2 Tree History:
Display a cross section of a tree trunk and relate the annual rings to historical events in your family, community, county and country.

CLASS 2- HISTORICAL DISPLAYS

Premiums: 1st-\$6.00 2nd - \$5.00 3rd - \$4.00

Lot 1 Display of antique forestry harvesting tools.
Lot 2 Display of pictures and stories of logging and timber harvesting in Beltrami County in the past or present.
