GENERAL INFORMATION

- All livestock entries must be PRE-REGISTERED with the **Superintendent** and the **Fair Office** no later than one week prior to entry day.
- Pens and stalls will be assigned by the superintendent on a first-come, first served basis, according to pre-registration date.
- It is understood that all exhibitors will be responsible for all care, feeding, watering, and cleaning of stalls and exhibit while animals remain at the Fair. Limited Straw available
- Animals must be in show condition. All exhibitors must sign the IAFE (International Association of Fairs and Expositions) National Code of Show Ring Ethics.
- Number of exhibits per exhibitor may be limited if space is not available.
- Sheep must have been owned 30 days prior to showing.
- Supervisor will require pedigree on all purebred animals.
- Exhibitor may not exhibit more than two breeds of sheep.
- Exhibitors must supply their own feed. Bedding is provided.
- All animals must have a Scrapies tag.
- Release time is 5 PM on Sunday. (No early releases)
- Barn hours 7 AM to 10 PM. No parking in front of loading areas on South end of barns.

PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED - contact Mr. Rohde

- Registration papers must be presented at check-in time.
- Wednesday entry time is 4:00 pm to 9:00 pm
- Thursday entry time is 9am to 12pm.
- No Late Entries will be allowed.

The base date for computing age will be September 1 of previous year. Regardless of birth date, lambs must show a lamb mouth. Birthdates:

- Senior Lamb:** Born between September 1st and December 31st of the previous year for all classes.
- Winter Lamb:** Born between January 1st and February 14th of current year for all classes.
- Spring Lamb:** Born on or after February 15th of current year.
- Yearling:** Born before September 1st of previous year.
