## CAMPING RULES SUMMARY

**GOAL:** The Beltrami County Agricultural Association strives to maintain the Fairgrounds and provide for an enjoyable stay at our campgrounds. To meet that goal, we request that camping guests are aware of and heed the guidelines in place. Please know that failure to follow these rules can or will result in dismissal from the Fairgrounds. This document summarizes the highlights of our camping policy. Please see the entire document on our website and/or copies that are available at the office. THANK YOU for camping at our Fairgrounds. We hope you enjoy your stay.

**CAMP HOST:** a Camp Host is in charge of all campgrounds at the Fairgrounds during the Fair. He will answer questions, assist with parking and help with any amenities needed.

**REGISTRATION:** registration for NON-FAIR camping is available by either calling or stopping at the Fair Office or using the camping registration packets located in the black boxes mounted on the wall of the Midway and Commercial bathrooms. FAIR camping requires reservations made by July 1 of each year. In either case the permit provided must be visibly displayed at all times in your camper or vehicle.

**FAIR/EVENT CAMPING:** please make yourself aware of the rules regarding camping including overnight campers governed by an adult, 18 years or older.

**CODE OF CONDUCT/EXPECTATIONS:** Camp quiet hours are from 11 PM- 6 AM. Unlawful behavior including use of fireworks or firearms (not allowed on the grounds at any time), loud parties, disrespectful behavior towards other guests or causing problems will not be tolerated. The BCAA strives to maintain a family friendly atmosphere at all times at the Fairgrounds. Laws regarding use of illegal substances or alcohol at any campsites are subject to the State of Minnesota statutes and will be enforced as necessary.

**OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLES/ATV and OHVs:** State of Minnesota laws regarding the use of off-highway vehicles are strictly enforced on the Fairgrounds at all times. Reckless driving, damaging roads or infrastructure and endangering others is not permitted and will be reported to law enforcement. During the Fair there are additional specific rules of use in place to avoid congestion or accidents due to the number of people on the grounds. Please make yourself aware of these.
