- Kids classes: Please put age on information card, and if the youngster had help making the item, please tell who helped, what the helper did and what the child did.

Special Instructions:

- Bring garment entries on a hanger; they may be encased in a clear plastic dry cleaner's bag.
- Keep entries that are a set together; place the set in a clear plastic bag or pin the pieces to each other.
- Enter only items that are completed, clean and NEW in appearance. Entries that show wear or stain may not be judged.
- Enter Quilted items in classes 160 -185 or Combined Textile Workclass 280.
